Judge Garcia also commented that the Border Security Bill has great potential of hurting the County's budget, yet 45 million dollars will be set aside to assist the border counties budgetary issues. He added that it is not known what will result from the Border Security Bill.

Canine Henri has been having back problems. The handler has noted difficulty in jumping and trouble defecating. On physical exam his lumbar spine was uncomfortable on palpation. There was no pain on extension of the hips. X-rays showed decreased disc spaces and lumbar space L4-5, L5-6, L6-7 and spondylosis at the same spaces. Also noted was spondylosis at L7-S1 which is where the pelvis attaches to the spine. Most likely he has genetically weak ligaments that hold the discs in place causing fusion/spondylosis of the bones of the spine. He also has lumbosacral instability. The problems will continue to worsen to the point where he will be unable to work. It would be best for him to stop working as his quality of work will suffer due to pain.
