**HIDALGO COUNTY – NATIONAL DISLOCATED WORKER DISASTER RECOVERY PROJECT GRANT
WORKSITE AGREEMENT EXTENSION**

The NDW grant providing your precinct temporary workers to perform disaster recovery work due to storm damage of June/Oct 2015 has been extended from June 30, 2016 to September 30, 2016. Any extensions will be based on your Precinct's demonstrated continuing need for these temporary workers. Your current Worksite Agreement ends on June 30, 2016. Your Worksite Agreements must be extended before June 30, 2016 in order for the temporary workers to continue working past June 30, 2016. No Worksite Agreement may be extended past September 30, 2016. In addition, **PLEASE NOTE:** due to grant close out procedures, payroll processing deadlines and the provision of employment transitioning services to the temporary workers by Workforce Solutions, the temporary workers' actual last day on-site will be September 23, 2016.
