WHEREAS, Hidalgo County District Clerk Laura Hinojosa was elected by her colleagues to serve as Secretary on the Executive Board for the County and District Clerk Association of Texas at its annual conference in June; and

She has distinguished herself as a committed public servant dedicated to preserving and maintaining the judicial records of the County of Hidalgo and the State of Texas. As District Clerk, Ms. Hinojosa believes in progress through strong working relationships and collaboration.
