Dear Mr. Nolting:

In order to proceed with approval of the **"Second Amendment"** in connection to **Contract # C-14-088-02-11** with **Kevin Nolting d/b/a Nolting, LLC** for **"Consulting Services"** of **The Medicaid 1115 Waiver which funds Uncompensated care and (DSRIP) for Hidalgo County**, the County is required, as of **January 1, 2016**, to comply with **Texas Government Code, §2252.908**, and the rules issued by the Texas Ethics Commission found in Title 1, Section 46.1, 46.3 and 46.5 of the Texas Administrative Code. In accordance with these requirements for the type of contract being considered, a business must submit a completed **Certificate of Interested Parties Form 1295**, to the County before the County may enter into a contract with the business entity.

In order for County staff to process the above referenced agreement, you must complete Form 1295 and file Form 1295 with the Texas Ethics Commission. You can find the 1295 form through the Texas Ethics Commission at the following website:

In box 3 of **Form 1295**, provide the **Contract No.: C-14-088-02-11** shown above. Once completed and filed with the Texas Ethics Commission, Form 1295 must be printed and signed in the presence of a notary and submitted to our office by the deadline stated below.

In order to maintain the schedule for presentation to **Commissioners Court on June 13, 2016**, the signed **notarized Form 1295** must be received in our office completed via fax to (956) 292-7612 or via email to: Martha.Salazar@co.hidalgo.tx.us with cc Leticia.saenz@co.hidalgo.tx.us **by Monday, June 13, 2016**. Hidalgo County cannot enter into a contract until Form 1295 is submitted, therefore, failure to timely submit Form 1295 signed, and notarized may result in delay of award.

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO
CONTRACT #C-14-088-02-11**

This **AMENDMENT** to the **CONTRACT** is made this **20th** day of **June of 2016** by and between **HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS** (the "COUNTY") and **KEVIN NOLTING, DBA, NOLTING CONSULTING LLC.** (the "CONSULTANT").

WHEREAS, County and Consultant entered into a Contract on February 11, 2014 (the "CONTRACT") in which the Consultant agreed to assist and support Hidalgo County with its Anchor Duties as described in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the County now requires an amendment to extend the "term" of the Contract in connection with The 1115 Waiver, which funds Uncompensated Care and the Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment Program (DSRIP), in which was extended 15 months under an agreement between the health agency and CMS. The agreement will take the program through or the expiration of December 31, 2017.

WHEREAS, the parties have now determined to amend the Contract as hereinafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the terms and provisions of this Second Amendment to the Service Contract, both parties hereby agree to the following amendment to the Contract.

1. **The term:** to extend the period of service with date to expire on December 31, 2017;
2. Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions of the Contract, as amended, remain in full force and effect. County and Consultant ratify and confirm the terms and provisions of the Contract as amended.
