## NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR A WATER USE PERMIT

### APPLICATION NO. 13195

Hidalgo County Drainage District No. 1 seeks authorization to construct and maintain an off-channel reservoir (Panchita Reservoir); and to divert water from a diversion point on the South Main Drain (Diversion Point 1) and three diversion segments on the North Main Drain and Main Floodwater Channel (Diversion Segments 1 - 3), Nueces-Rio Grande Coastal Basin, for domestic, municipal, mining, agricultural, industrial, hydroelectric power generation, recreational, flood control and water quality purposes or for storage in the Panchita Reservoir or existing off-channel reservoirs owned by the Santa Cruz Irrigation District and the Engleman Irrigation District for subsequent diversion and use in Hidalgo and Willacy Counties. More information on the application and how to participate in the permitting process is given below.

**APPLICATION.** Hidalgo County Drainage District No. 1, 902 North Doolittle Road Edinburg, Texas 78542, Applicant, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for Water Use Permit pursuant to Texas Water Code §§ 11.121, 11.042, 11.046 and TCEQ Rules Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 295.1, *et seq.* Notice is being published and mailed to the water right holders of record in the Nueces-Rio Grande Coastal Basin pursuant to Title 30 TAC § 295.151.

Applicant seeks authorization to construct and maintain an off-channel reservoir (Panchita Reservoir); and to divert and use not to exceed 62,712 acre-feet of water per year from a diversion point on the South Main Drain (Diversion Point 1) and three diversion segments on the North Main Drain and Main Floodwater Channel (Diversion Segments 1 - 3), Nueces-Rio Grande Coastal Basin, at a maximum combined diversion rate of 659.89 cfs (296,158 gpm) for domestic, municipal, mining, agricultural, industrial, hydroelectric power generation, recreational, flood control and water quality purposes or for storage in the Panchita Reservoir or existing off-channel reservoirs owned by the Santa Cruz Irrigation District and the Engleman Irrigation District for subsequent diversion and use in Hidalgo and Willacy Counties.

Panchita Reservoir will be located at located N 51° W, 16,830 feet from the SE corner of the V. Ynojosa Original Survey, Abstract No. 75, 17 miles in a northeastern direction from the City of Edinburg, at Latitude 26.324179° N and Longitude 97.903773° W in Hidalgo County, in ZIP code 78562. The final design capacity of Panchita Reservoir is unknown at this time.

Santa Cruz Irrigation Reservoir has a capacity of 4,250 acre-feet and is located N 55°W, 37,165 feet from the SE corner of the J. Balli Original Survey, Abstract No. 290, 6 miles in a northwestern direction from the City of Edinburg, at Latitude 26.388328° N and Longitude 98.169683° W in Hidalgo County, in ZIP code 78539.

Engleman Irrigation Reservoir has a capacity of 720 acre-feet and is located N 85°E, 19,900 feet from the SW corner of the V. Ynojosa Original Survey, Abstract No. 75, 10 miles in a northeastern direction from the City of Edinburg, at Latitude 26.321398° N and Longitude 98.019317° W in Hidalgo County, in ZIP code 78543.

The proposed diversion point and diversion segments are described as follows:

Diversion Point 1 is located on the South Main Drain, S 89° E, 7,465 feet from the NW corner of the J. Balli Original Survey, Abstract No. 54, 10 miles in a northeastern direction from the City of Edinburg, at Latitude 26.313891° N and Longitude 98.023139° W in Hidalgo County, in ZIP code 78543.

The upstream limit of Diversion Segment 1 is located on the Main Floodwater Channel, N 57° W, 24,250 feet from the SE corner of the V. Ynojosa Original Survey, Abstract No. 75, 17 miles in a northeastern direction from the City of Edinburg, at Latitude 26.330833° N and Longitude 97.926389° W in Hidalgo County, in ZIP code 78562.

The downstream limit of Diversion Segment 1 is located on the Main Floodwater Channel, N 49° W, 18,523 feet from the SE corner of the V. Ynojosa Original Survey, Abstract No. 75, 17 miles in a northeastern direction from the City of Edinburg, at Latitude 26.328611° N and Longitude 97.906389° W in Hidalgo County, in ZIP code 78562.

The upstream limit of Diversion Segment 2 is located on the North Main Drain, N 53° W, 34,352 feet from the SE corner of the J. Balli Original Survey, Abstract No. 290, 6 miles in a northern direction from the City of Edinburg, at Latitude 26.384122° N and Longitude 98.162650° W in Hidalgo County, in ZIP code 78539.

The downstream limit of Diversion Segment 2 is located on the North Main Drain, N 52°W, 32,322 feet from the SE corner of the J. Balli Original Survey, Abstract No. 290, 6 miles in a northern direction from the City of Edinburg, at Latitude 26.382197°N and Longitude 98.156549°W in Hidalgo County, in ZIP code 78539.

The upstream limit of Diversion Segment 3 is located on the Main Floodwater Channel, N 49°W, 18,523 feet from the SE corner of the V. Ynojosa Original Survey, Abstract No. 75, 17 miles in a northeastern direction from the City of Edinburg, at Latitude 26.328611°N and Longitude 97.906389°W in Hidalgo County, in ZIP code 78562.

The downstream limit of Diversion Segment 3 is located on the Main Floodwater Channel, S 12°W, 55,290 feet from the NE corner of the Jose Narciso Cabazos Original Survey, Abstract No. 8, 7.4 miles in a southwestern direction from Port

Mansfield, at Latitude 26.455278°N and Longitude 97.473611°W in Willacy County, in ZIP code 78598.

Applicant seeks authorization to divert a maximum amount of water from each diversion location, as follows: 12,288 acre-feet per year from Diversion Point 1; 44,940, 29,148, and 62,712 acre-feet per year from Diversion Segments 1 - 3, respectively, with a maximum combined diversion amount of not to exceed 62,712 acre-feet of water per year from all diversion locations.

Applicant indicates that the amount of water that would be available for diversion from each location will depend on the amount of water that is diverted upstream.

Applicant indicates that the water requested for appropriation includes irrigation and municipal return flows that are discharged into the South Main Drain, North Main Drain and Main Floodwater Channel.

Applicant also seeks to use the bed and banks of the South Main Drain, North Main Drain, and Main Floodwater Channel to convey the return flows.

Applicant further seeks to divert water from Diversion Segment 2 on the North Main Drain, and discharge the water into the Raymondville Drain, Nueces-Rio Grande Coastal Basin and in La Sal Vieja in Hidalgo and Willacy Counties.

The application and partial fees were received on May 11, 2015. Additional information and fees were received July 13, September 25, and November 3, 2015. The application was declared administratively complete and filed with the Office of the Chief Clerk on November 20, 2015. Additional information was received on December 4, 2015.

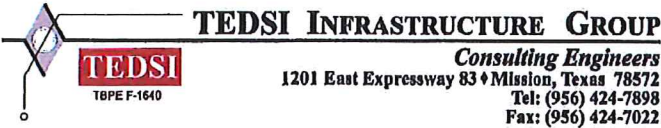

WHEREAS, the State of Texas, ("State"), acting by and through the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT"), proposes to make certain highway improvements on that section of the above-indicated highway; and

WHEREAS, the Hidalgo County Drainage District No. 1, ("Utility"), proposes to adjust or relocate certain of its facilities, if applicable, and retain title to any property rights it may have on, along or across, and within or over such limits of the highway right of way as indicated by the location map attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and acknowledgements herein contained, the parties mutually agree as follows:

It is agreed that joint usage for both highway and utility purposes will be made of the area within the highway right of way limits as such area is defined and to the extent indicated on the aforementioned plans or sketches. Nothing in this Acknowledgement shall serve to modify or extinguish any compensable property interest vested in the Utility within the above described area. If the facilities shown in the aforementioned plans need to be altered or modified or new facilities constructed to either accommodate the proposed highway improvements or as part of Utility's future proposed changes to its own facilities, Utility agrees to notify TxDOT at least 30 days prior thereto, and to furnish necessary plans showing location and type of construction, unless an emergency situation occurs and immediate action is required. If an emergency situation occurs and immediate action is required, Utility agrees to notify TxDOT promptly. If such alteration, modification or new construction is in conflict with the current highway or planned future highway improvements, or could endanger the traveling public using said highway, TxDOT shall have the right, after receipt of such notice, to prescribe such regulations as necessary for the protection of the highway facility and the traveling public using said highway. Such regulations shall not extend, however, to requiring the placement of intended overhead lines underground or the routing of any lines outside of the area of joint usage above described.

If Utility's facilities are located along a controlled access highway, Utility agrees that ingress and egress for servicing its facilities will be limited to frontage roads where provided, nearby or adjacent public roads and streets, or trails along or near the highway right of way lines which only connect to an intersecting road. Entry may be made to the outer portion of the highway right of way from any one or all access points. Where supports, manholes or other appurtenances of the Utility's facilities are located in medians or interchange areas, access from the through-traffic roadways or ramps will be allowed by permit issued by the State to the Utility setting forth the conditions for policing and other controls to protect highway users. In an emergency situation, if the means of access or service operations as herein provided will not permit emergency repairs as required for the safety and welfare of the public, the Utility shall have a temporary right of access to and from the through-traffic roadways and ramps as necessary to accomplish the required repairs, provided TxDOT is notified immediately when such repairs are initiated and adequate provision is made by Utility for the convenience and safety of highway traffic. Except as expressly provided herein, the Utility's rights of access to the through-traffic roadways and/or ramps shall be subject to the same rules and regulations as apply to the general public.
