

- c. One Continuing Education Credit (CEC) received toward annual CFM® recertification, in coordination with ASFPM.

SECTION 3. Membership Dues Dues are determined by the Board of Directors with recommendation from the Finance and Membership Committees.

SECTION 4. Membership Period – The membership period is for one calendar year from January through December. Dues are required as of January 1st and will be considered delinquent if not paid by March 1st. If the dues are delinquent, membership status will be inactive, and all membership benefits, including voting rights, shall cease. If the dues have not been paid by the end of the calendar year in which they are due, membership shall cease.

SECTION 5. Collection of Dues. The Executive Office will include a dues notice with the CFM® renewal notice that will be sent to all Certified Floodplain Manager members. The Executive Office will be responsible for sending out a dues notice to the Non Certified Floodplain Manager members. All dues are to be submitted to the Executive Office.

ARTICLE II

Meeting of the General Membership

SECTION 1. Annual Meeting – The annual meeting of the Association shall be held in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. Every two years, at the annual meeting there shall be an election of a Board of Directors for the Association. At the annual meeting, the general membership may establish policy by resolution, may amend the Bylaws, may consider and revise proposed amendments to the Articles of Incorporation, and may conduct other business and activities. The annual meeting of the general membership shall be held in conjunction with the Association's annual conference, at a time and place specified by the President or the Executive Director.

SECTION 2. Special Meetings – All business and activities that may be conducted at an annual meeting, except for election of the Board of Directors, may be conducted at special meetings. Special meetings of the Association may be called at any time by the Board of Directors.

SECTION 3. Notice of All Meetings – Written notice of each meeting of the Association shall be given to each member at least 21 calendar days in advance of the meeting. Such notice shall specify the place, day and hour of the meeting, and general agenda, and, in the case of a special meeting, the purpose of the meeting.

SECTION 4. Quorum - A quorum at a membership meeting shall consist of at least 10% of the voting members of the Association.
