Funding Availability

The Homeland Security Grants Division (HSGD) of the Governor's Office is soliciting grant applications for the following grant programs.

Due Dates

Applications **must** be certified by the applicant agency's Authorized Official no later than **5 PM CST** on the following date(s):

Thursday, March 30, 2017

- Border Prosecution Unit (BPU)
- Local Border Security Program (LBSP)

Submission Process

There are three phases to development of an application:

Create - direct your Grant Writer to create and complete the initial application;

Submit - your Grant Writer will then submit the initial application to HSGD online which notifies the Authorized Official by email;

Certify - once the application content - as submitted by the Grant Writer - has been approved by your organization, ask the individual assigned as the Authorized Official to certify to send the official application for funding consideration to HSGD online in eGrants.

IMPORTANT NOTE: An application must be certified by the Authorized Official before it is accepted by HSGD for funding consideration. Applications not certified by the due date/time will not be considered for funding.
