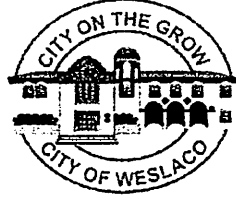

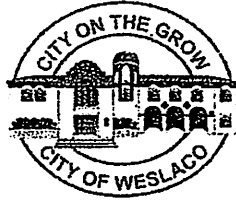
Geotechnical Firm, Raba Kistner, as well as TEDSI Infrastructure have recommended an alternate road section during the construction of the Border Avenue Project. In order to improve road efficiencies, three sections were analyzed to ensure cost implications were as low as possible. Option No. 1 changes the original design to add lime treatment to the subgrade in the total amounts of 4.5-5.5% with a cost increase of \$72,117. Option No. 2 increases the flexible base of the project by 4 inches, the subgrade treatment was kept the same, but added the use of a non-woven fabric between base and subgrade. This option implies an increase in cost of \$145,559.24. Option No. 3 included the use of the non-woven fabric and reduces the subgrade treatment section to 6 inches, but it treats with lime at 4.5-5.5% being an increase in cost of \$67,769.24.

Per our discussion on this item, we have agreed to recommend Option No. 1 with a cost increase of \$72,117.
