# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Fiscal Year September 1, 2017 – August 31, 2018

The **County Indigent Health Care Program** assists residents of Hidalgo County in need of Health Care Assistance. Eligibility for the program is determined by reviewing income, resources, household composition and county residence. Applicants with countable income in excess of **30%** of the Federal Poverty guideline do not qualify nor do those with countable resources in excess of **\$2,000/\$3,000** depending on household composition. Applicants or Authorized Representatives are required to complete an application and participate in an interview.

Assistance is provided for the following **Basic Health Care Services**: Hospital Services, Physician Services, (3) Prescription Drugs per month, Family Planning, Skilled Nursing Facility Services, Rural Health Clinic Services, Lab/X-Ray services, Immunizations, Annual Physical Exams, and Medical Screening Services.

Assistance is provided for the following **Optional Health Care Services**: Diabetic Supplies & Equipment only, services provided by physician assistants, nurse practitioners, certified nurse midwives, clinical nurse specialists, and certified registered nurse anesthetists.
