Mr. Espinosa,

Our office has reviewed the proposed Amendments between the multiple entities and the County Tax Assessor Collector's Office which was approved subject to legal review on the Commissioner's Court Agenda for July 25, 2017, and at this time approve as to the form of the amendments.

We have also reviewed the correspondence provided to you office from the Auditor's Office regarding payments to Delinquent Tax Attorney Firms on behalf of Various Taxing Entities. While the proposed amendments address the Auditor's concerns about complying with payment practices under prior interlocal agreements or contracts with entities, they do not address the Auditors concerns about payments to tax attorney firms that may be subject to IRS reporting on Form 1099.

As such, our office would recommend that the Tax Assessor Collector immediately communicate with the Auditor's Office and request assistance in establishing appropriate protocols and/or polices and procedures to document and issue the applicable forms that may be required by the IRS.
