Dear Ms. Yearwood:

Child Evangelism Fellowship of East Texas, Incorporated is exempt from Texas franchise tax as a 501(c)(3) group organization effective March 18, 1964 and from Texas sales and use tax effective August 29, 1977. The exemption does not extend to hotel occupancy tax.

We have assigned Texas taxpayer number 17514828700 to the organization. Please reference this number in correspondence with us. The assignment of the taxpayer number does not mean the organization is permitted to collect or remit Texas taxes. Exempt organizations must collect taxes on most of their sales. Please give our Tax Assistance section a call at 1-800-252-5555 if you need a sales tax permit.

The sales tax exemption extends to goods and services purchased for use by your organization. The exemption does not apply if the purchase is for the personal benefit of an individual or private party, or is not related to the organization's exempt purpose. For more information, please see our publication # 96-122, *Exempt Organizations - Sales and Purchases*.

The enclosed exemption certificate can be issued instead of paying tax when buying taxable items related to the exempt purpose of the organization. Make as many copies of the exemption certificate as you need. The exemption certificate does not need a taxpayer number to be valid, but you may provide your taxpayer number if the seller requests it.

Changes to the organization's registered agent and registered office address must be filed with the Texas Secretary of State. The changes can be made online at <http://www.sos.state.tx.us/corp/sosda/index.shtml> or you can download the forms and instructions from <http://www.sos.state.tx.us/corp/nonprofit.shtml>. You can also contact them at corpinfo@sos.state.tx.us or by calling (512) 463-5582. It is important to maintain current registered agent information, because this is how we will contact you if we have reason to believe that your organization no longer qualifies for exemption.

Gentlemen:

This refers to the information submitted for use in determining your status and the status of your subordinate units for Federal income tax purposes.

Our records show that in a ruling dated August 28, 1964, we held the Child Evangelism Fellowship International exempt from Federal income tax as an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. In our ruling of June 21, 1950, we held the National Child Evangelism Fellowship of the U.S.A., exempt under section 101(6) of the 1939 Code, which corresponds to section 501(c)(3) of the 1954 Code. The latter organization was issued a group ruling to cover its subordinate units on November 6, 1956.

The information submitted shows that the National Child Evangelism Fellowship of the U.S.A., was merged on May 3, 1966, into the Child Evangelism Fellowship International and the name of the surviving corporation is Child Evangelism Fellowship Incorporated.

Based on the information supplied, we rule that you and your subordinate units named on the group exemption roster you submitted are exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as it is shown that you and such units are organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes.

You and your subordinate units are not required to file Federal income tax returns so long as you and your exempt subordinate units retain a tax exempt status.


3. For subordinate units added to the roster, a letter signed by one of your principal officers containing or attaching:
 - a. a statement that the information upon which your present group exemption letter is based applies to the new subordinate units;
 - b. a statement that each has given you written authorization to add its name to the roster;
 - c. a list of those to which the Service previously issued rulings or determination letters relating to exemption.
4. If applicable, a statement that your group exemption roster did not change during the year.

You should advise each of your exempt subordinate units of the exemption and the pertinent provisions of this ruling.

This ruling terminates the ruling addressed to the National Child Evangelism Fellowship of the U.S.A. as of May 3, 1966, the date of merger, and supersedes the ruling addressed to you under your former name, Child Evangelism Fellowship International. Also, the rulings which were issued to the subordinate units in their individual names.

The District Directors of Internal Revenue concerned are being advised of this action.
