South Texas College will provide 1.5 hours of HB 300 and HIPAA for Hidalgo County Health and Human Services Dept. employees.

Program Title: HB 300 and HIPAA

Program Length: 1.5 hours

Participants: minimum of 167 (divided into 4 sessions)

Dates: May 23 and 24, 2018

Time: Session 1: May 23, 9:00-10:30 a.m.
Session 2: May 23, 2:00-3:30 p.m.
Session 3: May 24, 9:00-10:30 a.m.
Session 4: May 24, 2:00-3:30 a.m.
Make-up session: TBD if needed

Tuition: Sessions 1-4: \$2.10 (\$1.40 x 1.5 hours) per participant
Make-up session: \$8.55 (\$5.70 x 1.5 hours) per participant (only if needed)

Processing fee: Sessions 1-4: \$0.32 (\$2.10 x 15%) per participant
Make-up session: \$1.28 (\$8.55 x 15%) per participant (only if needed)

Total: Sessions 1-4: \$2.42 per participant
Make-up session: \$9.83 per participant (only if needed)

Grand Total: Sessions 1-4: \$404.14 (\$2.42 x 167 participants)
Make-up session: \$98.30 (\$9.83 x 10 participants) (only if needed)

The minimum cost per group for 167 or fewer students shall remain at \$404.14 for sessions 1-4 and, if needed, the minimum cost for the make-up sessions for 10 or fewer students at \$98.30 as the "Recovery of Cost" in order for STC to complete training for all the remaining students.

Additional students will be charged at the rate of \$2.42 for sessions 1-4 and \$9.83 for the make-up session.

Failure to make payment in full within 90 days may result in the account being sent to collections. Hidalgo County Health and Human Services understands that the College may place for collection any delinquent or defaulted monies owed South Texas College.
