LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY ORDERING INSTRUCTIONS

To purchase weapons directly from SIG SAUER, the agency must provide:

- 1) **Agency Letter** stating the weapons are being purchased to be the property of the agency for the use of officers' authorized by law to make arrests and carry firearms in the performance of official duties and are not being acquired for the purpose of resale or transfer. Letter must also include agency training and duty ammunition, caliber and grain. **If the agency is submitting a purchase order, this letter must still accompany the PO.**
- 2) **Endorsed Federal Excise Tax (FET) Certificate**, must be **completed in full** with the date of purchase (1st box) or for a period of (3) years (2nd box) to be kept on file at Sig Sauer to be applicable for future purchases and signed by a "person of authority." (*normally the Chief of Police, Sheriff or Purchasing Agent*)
- 3) **Copy of the quotation.**

Agency Trades:

The Agency is responsible for the transportation and cost of shipping NON-SIG SAUER trade weapons to the designated dealer or, if trading SIG SAUER weapons, to the SIG SAUER manufacturing facility within sixty (60) days of receipt of new weapons. After 60 days, 1 ½% of the trade value will be deducted from the Agency credit, increasing 1 ½% every 30 days. Trades must be in working condition and shipped with the type and number of magazines specified. SIG SAUER will reduce the trade value by \$15 per missing magazine. Defective, non-working firearms or firearms with missing parts, will incur a 50% decrease from the quoted trade value. The Agency further understands SIG SAUER or the Distributor will sell the traded weapons in full compliance with federal, state and local laws.

Do **NOT** send Class III restricted weapons (select fire rifles or short barrel rifles/shotguns to SIG SAUER. Per BATF regulations, SIG SAUER will prepare a separate CLASS III bid and shipping instructions.



¹ A sale of an article to a State or local government for resale is not considered to be a sale for the "exclusive use" of the State or local government, within the meaning of section 4221(a)(4) of the code, and, therefore, such sales may not be made tax-free. Such sales may not be made tax-free even if the resales are made to government employees, or the article is an item of equipment the employee is required to possess in carrying out his duties.
