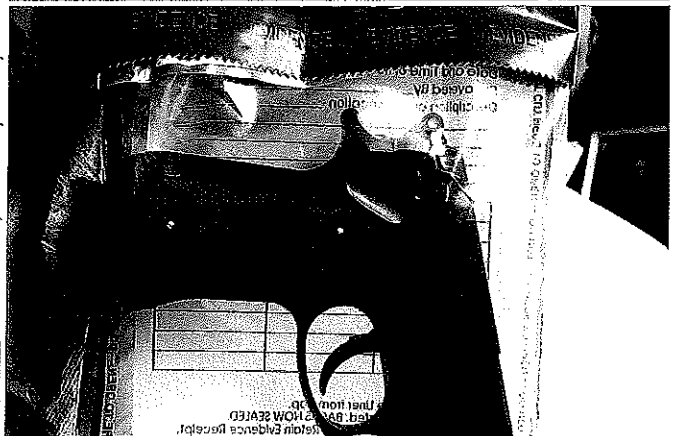
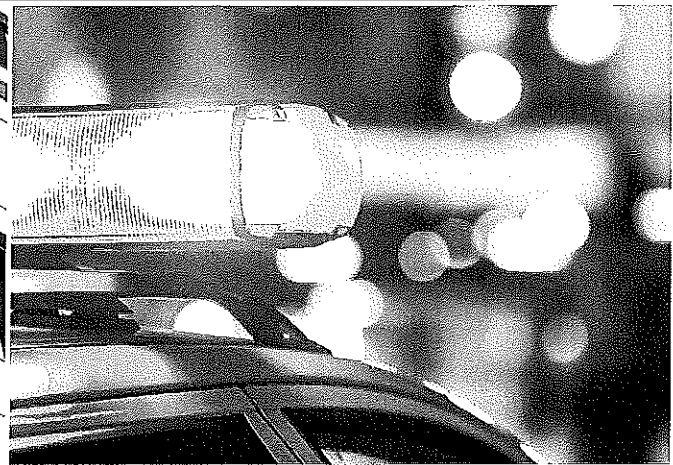
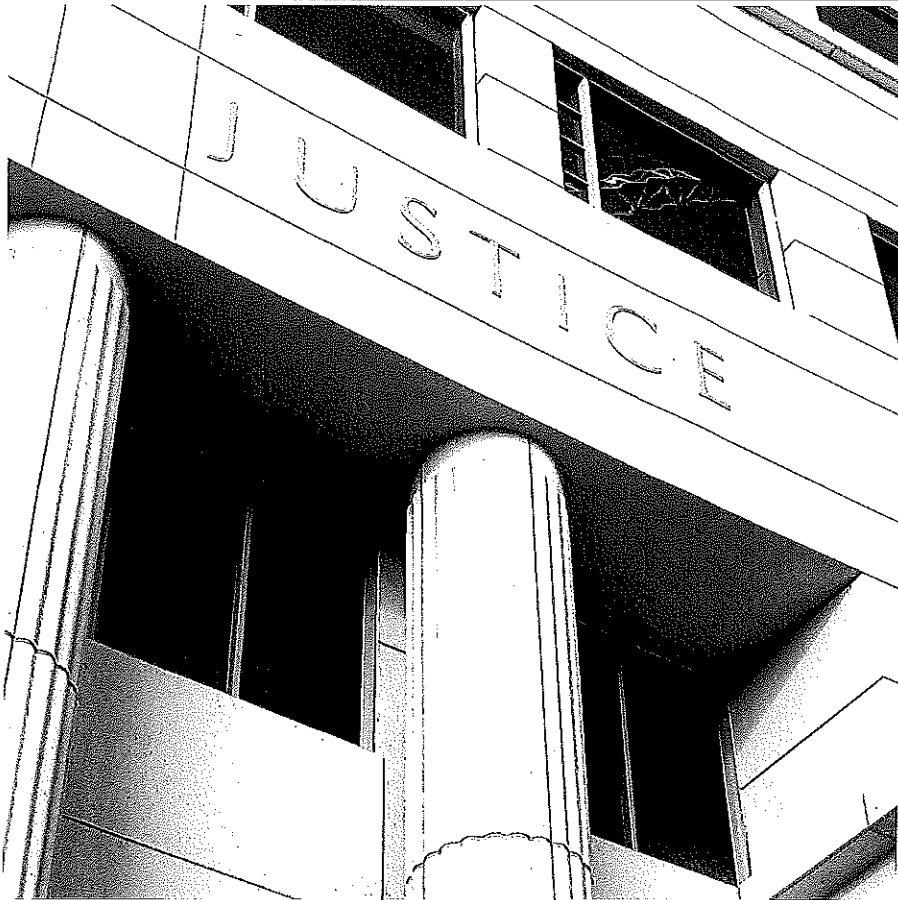

This program is designed to cover criminal law basics for beginners and as a good refresher course for the experienced practitioner. The goal of the course is to provide the nuts and bolts of how to handle a criminal case from beginning to end. Starting with general business practices and ending with how to file a notice of appeal. Given the enormity of the goal and the presentation time allotted, some topics will be addressed in the materials provided while others will be discussed during the presentations. The topics that will be covered include: fee contracts, marketing, jail release, bail reduction, standards for arrest, searches, oral and written confessions, the exclusionary rule, investigating the case, theory of the case, plea negotiations, the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct, *Brady v. Maryland*, discovery, pretrial motions, charging instruments, voir dire, trial practices, the Texas Rules of Evidence, the jury charge, Texas sentencing scenarios, collateral consequences of conviction, motions for new trial, and notice of appeal.

The course will be taught by three experienced criminal law practitioners. The presentations will be divided up into individual sessions in order to generally address the following wide ranging subjects: "Initiation of a Criminal Case," "Pretrial Considerations," and "Resolution from Negotiations to Trial." Where feasible and relevant, topics will be presented from the perspective of both the prosecution and the defense. Within each general topic, speakers will share specific information regarding practice tips, ethical dilemmas, substantive law, and trial advocacy pointers.

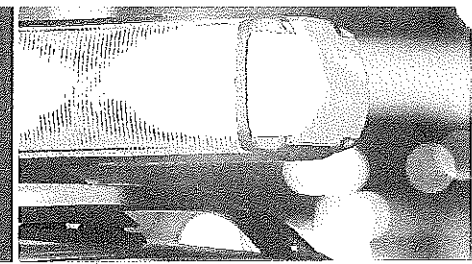

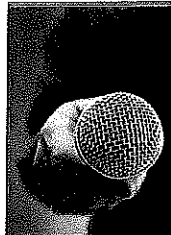

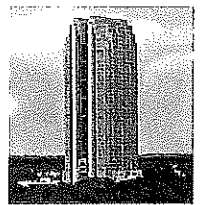
