

Letter of Intent between The Texas A&M University Health Science Center (“TAMHSC”), a health-related institution under the administration of Texas A&M University, a member of The Texas A&M University System, an agency of the State of Texas, on behalf of the School of Public Health (“SPH”) and Hidalgo County WIC Program.

Purpose: This letter of Intent between HSC-SPH and Hidalgo County WIC Program reflects the mutual desire to collaborate between both institutions in the area of public health and health systems. The WIC Program will assist in providing recruitment flyers for the programs of Asthma and Gestational Diabetes as well as a survey for the supervisors and staff of selected WIC Clinics in Hidalgo County. All material will be distributed through Ms. Clarissa Ramirez, Director of the WIC program in Hidalgo County.

Effective Date: The term of the agreement is **July 1st, 2018 through June 30, 2021**. The agreement may be amended by written mutual consent of both parties.
