

Proclamation Declaring September 2018 as Suicide Prevention Month

WHEREAS, in the United States, there are more than 1.7 million deaths by suicide annually – on average one person dies by suicide every three hours; and

WHEREAS, suicide is the 11th leading cause of death in Texas and the 2nd leading cause of death among individuals between the ages of 15 to 34; and

WHEREAS, many of the people who died never received effective behavioral health services, for many reasons including the difficulty of accessing services and the stigma of using behavioral health treatment; and

WHEREAS, all residents of Hidalgo County are urged to recognize suicide as a significant public health problem; support the development of accessible behavioral health services; and acknowledge that no single suicide prevention effort will be sufficient for all populations or communities; and

WHEREAS, the National Suicide Hotline is 1-800-273-TALK; everyone is encouraged to save this number and use it when you, a friend, or loved one is experiencing a crisis, so that lives can be saved; and

WHEREAS, the 2nd Hidalgo County Suicide Awareness and Prevention Event, hosted by Say Yes to Life, the Peralez Family, Chris Ardis, Vivian Velazquez Tamez, and the International Bacculaureate at Lamar Academy Student Council will be held at 6:30 p.m. on September 8, 2018 at North San Juan Park on 509 East Earling Road in San Juan.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court hereby designates September 2018, as “Suicide Prevention Month” in Hidalgo County and urges all Hidalgo County residents to learn how they can help raise awareness, heed warning signs, and encourage those in crisis to seek help.
