RECOMMENDATION: Administration recommends approval.

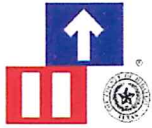

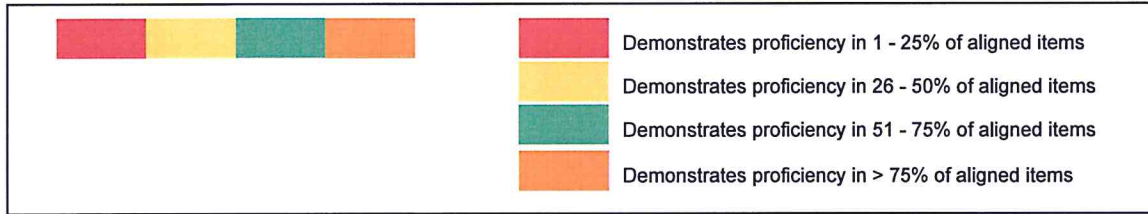

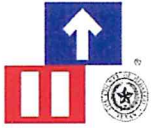
