**FOURTH AMENDMENT TO
CONTRACT #C-14-088-02-11**

This **AMENDMENT** to the **CONTRACT** is made this 23rd day of October, **2018** by and between **HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS** (the “**COUNTY**”) and **KEVIN NOLTING, DBA, NOLTING CONSULTING LLC.** (the “**CONSULTANT**”).

WHEREAS, County and Consultant entered into a Contract on February 11, 2014 (the “**CONTRACT**”) in which the Consultant agreed to assist and support Hidalgo County with its Anchor Duties as described in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the County now requires an amendment to extend the “term” of the Contract in connection with The 1115 Waiver, which funds Uncompensated Care and the Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment Program (DSRIP), as it has been extended an additional 2 years 9 months under an agreement between the COUNTY health agency and CMS. The agreement will now take the program through September 30, 2022.

WHEREAS, the parties have now determined to amend the Contract as hereinafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the terms and provisions of this Second Amendment to the Service Contract, both parties hereby agree to the following amendment to the Contract.

1. **The term:** to extend the period of service with date to expire on September 30, 2020, and providing the County with two additional one year options to renew;
2. Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions of the Contract, as amended, remain in full force and effect. County and Consultant ratify and confirm the terms and provisions of the Contract as amended.
