

FIRE HYDRANTS INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

1. Fill out a Fire Hydrant Installation Application.
2. Provide a 11"x17" utility layout plat.
3. Provide Warranty Deed, for the location Fire Hydrant is to be installed.
4. NAWSC is to conduct a hydraulic Analysis, based on the result hydrant will be approved for installation.
5. Pay \$850.00, for the legal fees on Waterline Access Agreement Letter.
- + 6. If the hydrant pertains to the City's ETJ or County jurisdiction, applicant is to provide from the entity an "Installation of Black Fire Hydrant" acceptance letter.
- + 7. If Fire Hydrant is to cross any of the TXDOT highways, applicant is to pay \$350.00, for permits fee. (except for County crossings.)
8. Applicant is required to hire the contractor under NAWSC Approved Contractors List, and pay for the materials needed for the installation.
9. Provide a Letter to Proceed from the City or County.
10. Once, the mentioned above requirements are met and the Waterline Access Agreement Letter has been executed or escrow, the contractor doing the installation can proceed to request a pre-construction meeting.
11. All water system improvements must be install according to TCEQ and NAWSC Specifications.
