WHEREAS, his first task was to provide financial assistance to many of the families affected by the freeze, and served in many capacities throughout the years; and



WHEREAS, his best memory was receiving a call from a client's family member after she had passed away, placing his name on a list of people to thank for their assistance during her struggle with cancer; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Ayala is happily married to Maribel and has one daughter, Daisy. He plans to retire to his home in Weslaco; enjoying his family.


