

VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN JUSTICE AND TRAINING PROGRAM RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Hidalgo County, that the Violence Against Women Justice and Training Program be operated for the FY 2021; and

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office Criminal Justice Division grant application; and

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office designates Richard F. Cortez as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.
