HONORING ADALBERTO RUBEN HINOJOSA FOR 34 YEARS OF SERVICE

WHEREAS, Captain Adalberto Ruben Hinojosa is being honored for his 34 years of outstanding service to the citizens of Hidalgo County as a member of the Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, Captain Hinojosa was born on November 9, 1961 in Edinburg, Texas to proud parents Janie Pardo Hinojosa (deceased) and Ruben Hinojosa; and

WHEREAS, Captain Hinojosa was raised in San Juan, Texas until his family moved to San Manuel, Texas in 1972; and

WHEREAS, Captain Hinojosa graduated from Edinburg High School in 1980 and attended Texas State Technical Institute in Harlingen, Texas where he received an associate degree in Ranch Management in 1982; and

WHEREAS, Captain Hinojosa began his career with the Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office on September 16, 1983 as a Detention Officer. During his career he has worked his way up; achieving the ranks of Deputy Sheriff, Academy Training Coordinator, Lieutenant, and his current rank of Captain. Among his many accomplishments, he earned his Master Jailers and Master Peace Officer License along with becoming a Certified Public Manager; and

WHEREAS, Captain Hinojosa has a distinguished record with the Sheriff's Office, most notably as one of the architects of Operation El Cibolo in 2003 where he was instrumental in coordinating and overseeing the largest prisoner transfer in the history of the Sheriff's Office from the old jail to the new facility in a 24 hour period without a single incident; and

WHEREAS, after over three decades of dedicated service, Captain Hinojosa will be retiring from his duties with the Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court does hereby honor Captain Adalberto Ruben Hinojosa for 34 years of outstanding, dedicated and committed service to the Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office and on this day wishes him a long and happy retirement.
