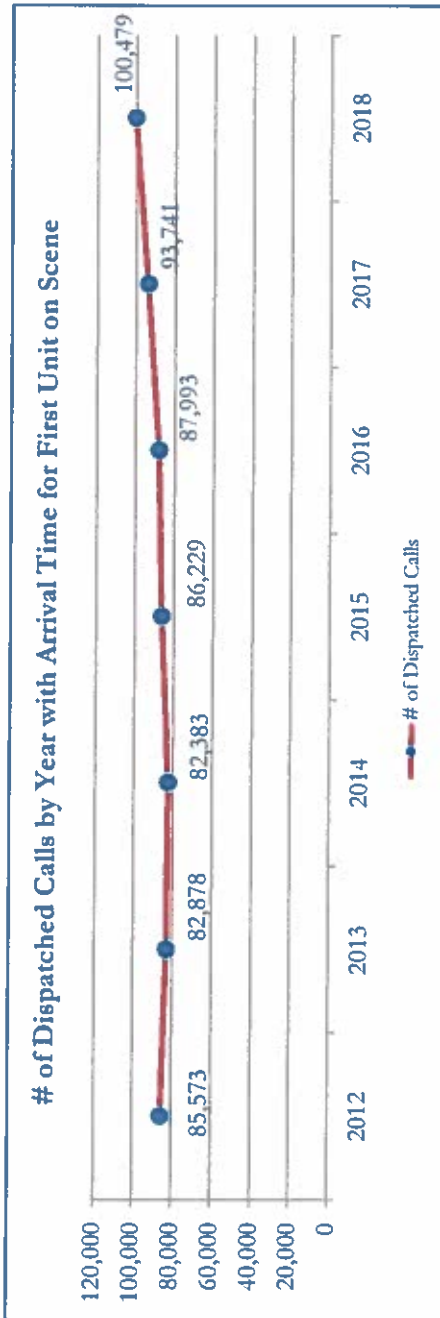

HCSO Patrol Response Times

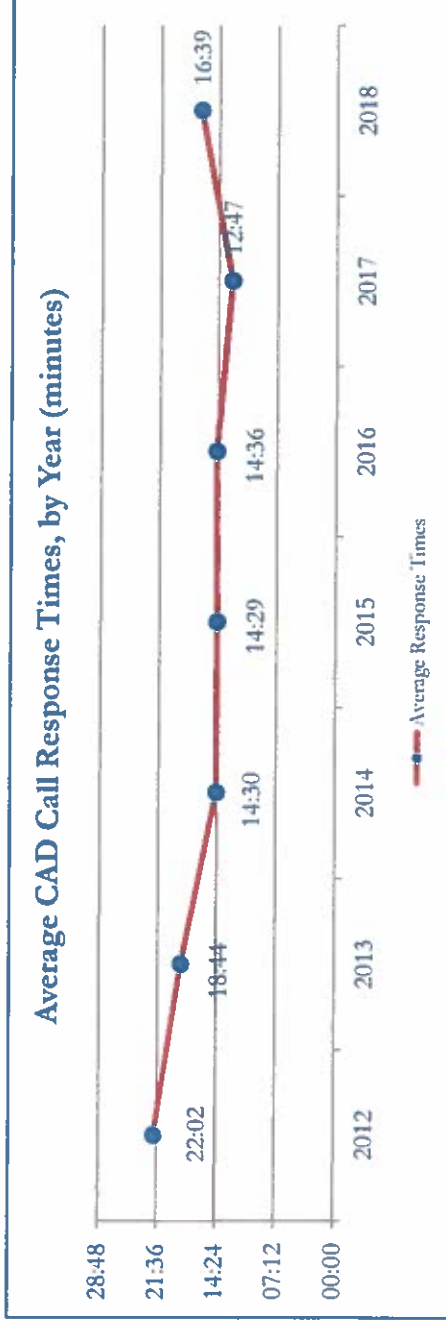

- Over 4660 students trained totaling 4598 hours of instruction
- Over 6055 students trained totaling 8453 hours of instruction
- Over 5670 students trained totaling 7325 hours of instruction
- Training is provided free of charge for our law enforcement partners, saving them on average \$100.00 per officer for every 8 hours of training
- In 2018, the HCSO Training Academy taught more than 115 active shooter courses for about 5000 civilians.
- In 2018, the HCSO hosted 9 jailer academies.
- In 2018, 109 different agencies availed themselves to HCSO instruction.

HCSO Training Academy

Tactical Medic Program

- The Creation of the HCSO Tactical Medic Program in 2017, which certified Deputies and Jailers as EMT's, ECA's & Canine Medics.
- The HCSO continues to equip its field personnel with life saving measures from basic first aid, to different levels of medic training to prepare them for critical emergencies.
- In 2018, the HCSO documented 3 Different incidents where these skills were utilized to save lives.
