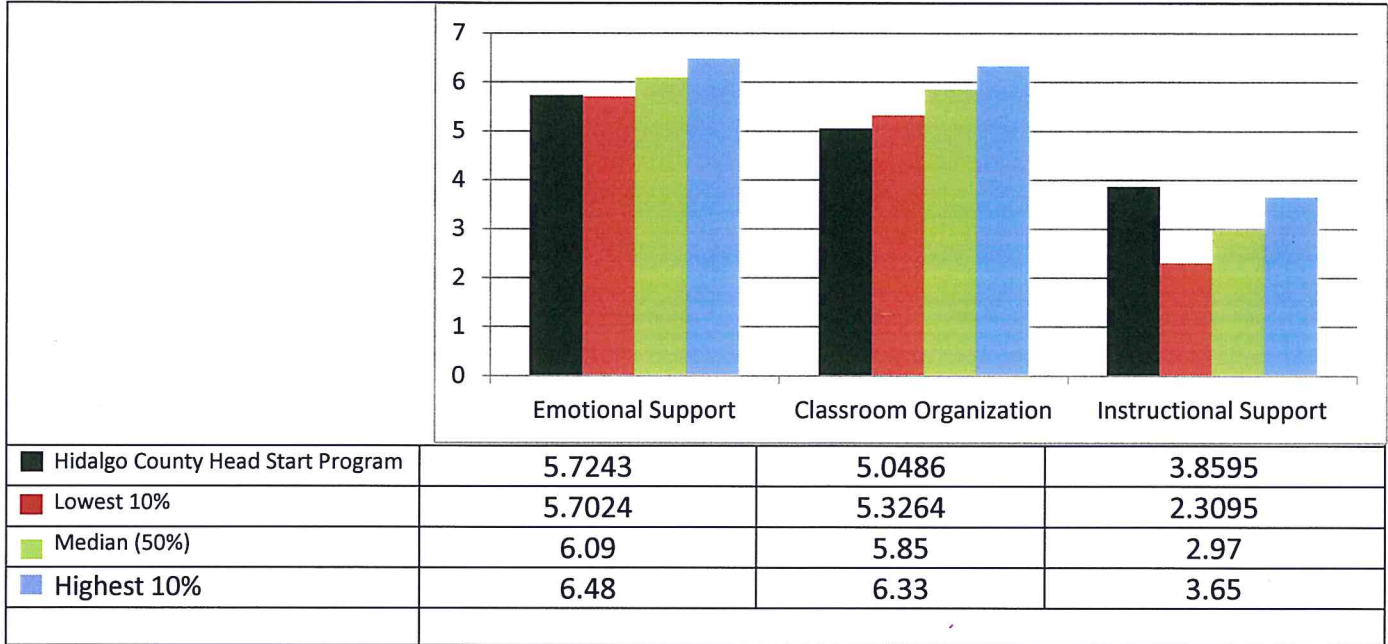

CLASS Results in Comparison to the National Lowest 10%



Each year the 10% of grantees reviewed that receive the lowest average scores in each domain are required to compete as a result of low CLASS scores.

If a Program scores in the bottom 10% of all Head Start Programs, this means that the vast majority of Head Start Programs were assessed at higher levels.
