**Resolution in Support of
Victim Assistance Program Grant**

WHEREAS, The County of Hidalgo and the Hidalgo County District Attorney’s Office finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Hidalgo County, that the Hidalgo County DA’s Office – Victim Assistance Program Grant be operated for the September 1, 2017 thru September 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, The County of Hidalgo Commissioners Court agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Texas Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division grant application; and

WHEREAS, The County of Hidalgo Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the County of Hidalgo Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, The County of Hidalgo Commissioners Court designates the Hidalgo County Judge as the grantee’s authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Hidalgo Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the Hidalgo County DA’s Office – Victim Assistance Program Grant to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
