

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF THE COMMISSIONER'S
COURT OF HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS
IN CONSIDERATION OF PLAN TO RENAME A PORTION OF
MILE 17 NORTH ROAD TO JAGUAR DRIVE**

Notice is hereby given that the Commissioner's Court of the County of Hidalgo, Texas (the County) will be accepting public comments regarding a request by the community to rename a portion of Mile 17 North between FM 907 (Alamo Road) and Terry Road in accordance with Texas Transportation Code § 251.013.

The County is considering renaming a portion of this road that provides access to Johnny G. Economedes High School, which has as its mascot the Jaguar, as follows:

- The portion of Mile 17 North between Alamo Road and Terry road shall be renamed to Jaguar Drive.

Any person who wishes to provide comments regarding this proposed change may do so on **Tuesday, April 23, 2019** at **2:00 p.m.**, in the Hidalgo County Commissioner's Courtroom, located at 100 E. Cano Street, 1st Floor, Edinburg, Texas 78539

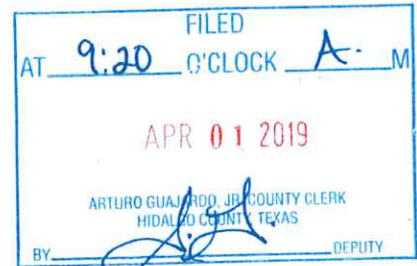

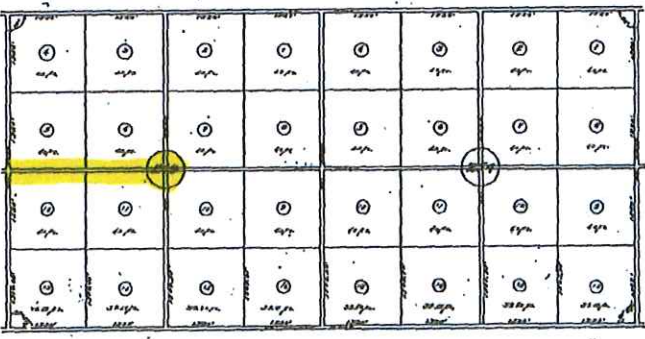

AN ORDER TO RE-NAME A PORTION OF MILE 17 NORTH TO JAGUAR DRIVE

WHEREAS, a plat recorded in the Hidalgo County Real Property Records on May 7, 1914, which subdivides two specified parcels of land, provides an explicit dedication for public use of all streets within the specified subdivided properties; and

WHEREAS, a road named by this plat as Mile 17 North is included among those roads that has been explicitly dedicated to use by the public through that dedication; and

WHEREAS, a portion of that road between FM 907 (Alamo Road) and Terry Road provides access to Johnny G. Economedes High School, which has as its mascot, the Jaguar; and

WHEREAS, the County has received a request from the community regarding Johnny G. Economedes High School to change the name of that portion of Mile 17 North between Alamo Road and Terry Road to Jaguar Drive; and

WHEREAS, Texas Transportation Code § 251.013 permits the commissioners court of a county to enter an order adopting a name for a public road after holding a public hearing and providing notice of such a hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court held a hearing on this day, after providing the public with at least two (2) weeks of notice before the date of this hearing; and

WHEREAS, after holding this hearing, the Commissioners Court is of the opinion that the name of this portion of public street should be changed to honor the mascot of Johnny G. Economedes High School;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT of HIDALGO COUNTY that:

1. The recitals set forth in this Order are true and correct.
2. The Hidalgo County Commissioners Court hereby re-names the portion of Mile 17 North from Alamo Road to Terry Road to Jaguar Drive in honor of the Jaguars of Johnny G. Economedes High School.
