

**AUTOMOBILE BURGLARY AND THEFT PREVENTION AUTHORITY GRANT RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, The Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Hidalgo County, that the Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority Grant be operated for the period of September 1, 2019 to August 31, 2020.
