Dear Grant Program Directorate,

The 2016 Operation Stonegarden Supplemental performance grant period is underway. Total funding awarded to Hidalgo County was \$870,948.59. These funds were shared with 2 local law enforcement agencies which were invited to participate in 2016 Operation Stonegarden and with TXDPS.

The Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office was approved a total of \$32,025.34 for the purchase of a Vigilant Commercial Account and \$105,025.34 for the purchase of and ten (10) License Plate Reader Systems. However, the Vigilant Commercial Account has already been purchased with previously approved OPSG FY 17 funds and the actual price for the ten (10) License Plate Reader Systems came out to be \$130,000.00.

The Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office wishes to move the Commercial Account funds from Supplies and Direct Operating Expenses in the total of \$32,025.34 to cover the remaining cost of the ten (10) License Plate Reader Systems.
