Grant Award Agreement

This Agreement is entered between the Texas Council on Family Violence (TCFV) and **County of Hidalgo by and through the Criminal District Attorney's Office** for the purpose of outlining expectations of both parties.

As grant recipient, **County of Hidalgo** agrees to the following:

1. Use the award amount of up to **(\$10,000)** exclusively for purposes and activities necessary to the provision of direct services. Examples: computers, consumable supplies, furniture, appliances, mattresses, play therapy supplies, etc.
2. Use the entire award amount by **August 16, 2019**.
3. Affirm funds will not be utilized for repairs or renovations.
4. Reporting:
 - a. Submit a short narrative (no more than 500 words) on impact to agency, survivors and / or provision of services by **September 30, 2019**. Photographs are optional but appreciated. They are shared with initial funder.
5. Documentation: This grant is a reimbursement, it will require full documentation and receipts of purchases. Please submit your reimbursement request by as soon as possible but not later than **August 28, 2019**.

TCFV agrees to do the following:

1. Issue reimbursement, with all necessary documentation intact, within 10 business days.
2. If due to cash flow constraints, the grant recipient is unable to purchase items, TCFV will make the purchases directly.

By signing this Agreement, both agencies indicate that they will fulfill the responsibilities cited above.
