**FOURTH AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
LOWER RIO GRANDE VALLEY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL
AND
THE COUNTY OF HIDALGO**

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2018 Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council and County of Hidalgo entered into an Interlocal Agreement;

WHEREAS, the Agreement was for the purpose of establishing the rights and responsibilities of each party in a public bus transportation project operated under the “Valley Metro” banner that will serve the citizens of Hidalgo County. The goal of the project is to provide access and mobility for County employees, the general public low-income persons, the disabled, the elderly, veterans, and others who require public transit to reach their employment locations, county services, and other destinations.

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Memorandum of Understanding as hereinafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the terms and provisions of this Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding and for good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Lower Rio Grande Development Council and the County of Hidalgo as approved as of the **27th day of August 2019**, hereby agrees to the following Amendment:

1. Section 4 (b). **EXTENSION OF SERVICES**: is hereby modified, revised, and/or replaced as follows:

COUNTY for the purpose of extending this current agreement for an additional 180 days commencing 31th day of August 2019 and expiring 28th day of February 2020 under the same terms and conditions.

2. Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement, as amended, remain in full all other provisions in the original agreement will remain in effect.
