Notice is hereby given that the County of Hidalgo Urban County Program has completed its Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2019.

This report is a comprehensive review of the activities undertaken by the Urban County Program in carrying out activities identified in the County's Consolidated Plan Strategy (CPS). The program operates in 17 non-entitlement communities and the rural areas of Hidalgo County.

A 15-day comment period is hereby established from August 22, 2019 to September 5, 2019. The CAPER report will be available for public viewing and comment at the Hidalgo County Urban County Program Office, Precinct No. 1, Precinct No. 2, Precinct No. 3, Precinct No. 4 and the seventeen (17) member city halls and public libraries. **Following the comment period, a Public Hearing will be held at 10:00 A.M. in Tuesday, September 10, 2019 at the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court meeting at 100 E. Cano St., Edinburg, Texas 78539.**

It is the objective of Hidalgo County to comply with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990 and the ADA Amendment Act of 2008, the Fair Housing Act, and the Architectural Barriers Act in all respects. Persons with disabilities/handicapped, non-English speaking, or limited English proficiency (LEP) who may require an interpreter shall be provided upon request by calling (956) 787-8127 at least three (3) days in advance. Persons who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, deaf-blind or speech-disabled may use Relay Texas at (800) 735-2989 to call the Hidalgo County Urban County Program (UCP) and request arrangements in order to participate in the citizen participation process.
