

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF THE COMMISSIONERS
COURT OF HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS
IN CONSIDERATION OF PLAN TO RENAME A COUNTY
PUBLIC ROAD TO TROOPER MOISES SANCHEZ
BOULEVARD**

Notice is hereby given that the Commissioner's Court of the County of Hidalgo, Texas (the County) will be accepting public comments regarding a request by retired Department of Public Safety State Trooper Johnny Hernandez and the City of Edinburg to rename a street commonly known as 10th Street, a public road located within the Sections of 235 and 238 of the Texas-Mexican Railway Company's Survey (North of Schunior and South of FM 1925), in accordance with Texas Transportation Code § 251.013.

The County is considering renaming the street, in honor of Texas Department of Public Safety State Trooper Moises Sanchez, a resident of Hidalgo County who was killed as a result while protecting the residents of Hidalgo County. In honor of State Trooper Moises Sanchez, the County of Hidalgo Commissioner's Court recommends that:

- 10th Street shall be renamed to State Trooper Moises Sanchez Boulevard

**AN ORDER TO RE-NAME A PORTION OF 10th STREET TO TROOPER MOISES
SANCHEZ BOULEVARD**

WHEREAS, a plat recorded in the Hidalgo County Real Property Records on August 30, 1913, which sub-divides two specified parcels of land, provides an explicit dedication for public use of all streets within the specified subdivided properties; and

WHEREAS, a road named by this plat as 10th Street is included among those roads that has been explicitly dedicated to use by the public through that dedication; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Moises Sanchez served proudly and honorably serving his Country in The United States Marine Corps from 1989 to 1991; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Moises Sanchez paid the ultimate sacrifice and was killed in the line of duty while protecting the citizens of Hidalgo County on August 24, 2019, as a result of injuries sustained on April 6, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the County of Hidalgo has received a request from retired Texas Department of Public Safety State Trooper Johnny Hernandez and the City of Edinburg to change the name of that portion of 10th Street from North Schunior Street to the South property line of lots two (2) and (3) Section 235 of the Texas-Mexican Railway Company's Survey to Trooper Moises Sanchez Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Texas Transportation Code § 251.013 permits the commissioners court of a county to enter an order adopting a name for a public road after holding a public hearing and providing notice of such a hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court held a hearing on this day, after providing the public with at least two (2) weeks of notice before the date of this hearing; and

WHEREAS, after holding this hearing, the Commissioners Court is of the opinion that the name of this portion of public street should be changed to honor State Trooper Moises Sanchez;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT of HIDALGO COUNTY that:

1. The recitals set forth in this Order are true and correct.
2. The Hidalgo County Commissioners Court hereby re-names the portion of 10th Street from North Schunior Street to the South property line of lots two (2) and (3) Section 235 of the Texas-Mexican Railway Company's Survey to Trooper Moises Sanchez Boulevard in honor of fallen Texas Department of Public Safety State Trooper Moises Sanchez.

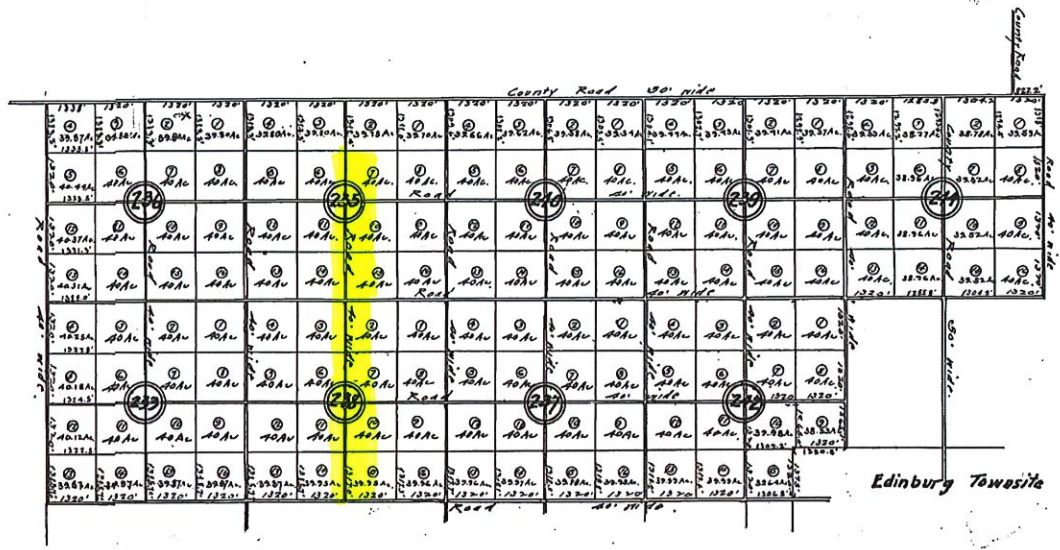
