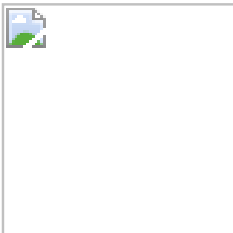

Good afternoon PR. I hope all is well with you today. As you know we have been working with the contractor to evaluate if a change order can be made on the subject project. We plan on meeting with Sam later today on another matter and will brief him on our approach. Once the contractor submits his pricing we will visit with you and Sam to start the change order process. However, before we can do that we need written approval that the proposed change order can be processed with part of it being material and labor and part labor only so the 25% limitation is not exceeded. HCDD1 will cover the balance of the cost of the change order by providing the material. We do not see a problem proceeding this way since the work is needed to alleviate drainage issues for the area and the proposed change order total will be within the engineer's probable

construction estimate for the work being considered. Once we get written approval we will work to get our current interlocal amended.

Please provide us with written approval regarding the approach we are taking for the change order so we can move forward.

Thank you for your help and we look forward to working with Hidalgo County Urban County to address drainage needs for our area.
