SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 3
To Work Authorization No. 2
of AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES
(C-17-182-06-13)

This **SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT** is made pursuant to the terms and conditions of Article 8 of the Agreement made by and between **HIDALGO COUNTY**, acting herein by and through the **Commissioner’s Court**, hereinafter called the “**Owner**”, and **B2Z ENGINEERING, LLC**, Professional Engineers of Mission, Texas, hereinafter called “**Engineer**”.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the **Owner** and the **Engineer** executed the **Agreement** on the **13th** day of **June 2017** concerning the **Engineer** to provide design and construction management services for “**Military Highway Extension**” (hereinafter referred to as the “**Project**”); and,

WHEREAS, Article 8 of the **Agreement**, (Supplemental Agreements), establishes that, “The terms of the Agreement may be amended by supplemental agreement if the Owner determines that [...] (3) for any other reason agreeable to the **Owner** and the **Engineer**”; and,

WHEREAS, due to project schedule, it has become necessary to replace R.O.W. Survey Services with Vickrey & Associates to complete the necessary survey services in a timely manner; and,

WHEREAS, Vickrey & Associates has assumed the remaining fee for proposed surveying services, thus no monetary change has occurred.

A. AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, the **Owner** and the **Engineer** agree that said **Agreement** is amended as follows:

- I. Vickrey & Associates replaces R.O.W. Survey Services for all remaining survey services within Supplemental No. 2 to Work Authorization No. 2.

All other provisions are unchanged and remain in full force and effect.
