Grant Officials,

As you may recall, this year we will not be requiring grantees to submit a Border Prosecution Unit FY21 application. I would like to inform everyone that funds were appropriated for two years and our office will work on awarding the same amount as FY20 by extending the period of performance to cover FY21. In addition to this change, there are \$2.1 M in deobligated BPU funds which will be reallocated among the jurisdictions according to the Executive Committee's recommendation. We anticipate to initiate the process of awarding the approved deobligated amounts along with next year's funds through one supplemental grant adjustment. Please expect a second email next week outlining the timeline for the supplemental process.
