H.B. 3834, now Texas Government Code 2054.519 and 2054.5191, mandates that each state agency provide a Department of Information Resources (DIR) certified cybersecurity training to all staff that must be completed on an annual basis.

HHS must also report contractors' compliance with Texas Government Code 2054.5192. To assist this effort, the HHS Webpage, *Contracting with HHS*, has been updated to inform contractors of the requirement and provide access to a *Contractor Written Acknowledgement of Completion of Cybersecurity Training Program (PDF)* form . This form must be completed by any HHS contractor, including the contractor's employees, officers, and subcontractors who have access to a Texas Health and Human Services system, computer system or database. The form certifies the contractor has completed a Department of Information Resource (DIR) certified cybersecurity awareness training program and is compliant with Texas Government Code 2054.5192.

Please complete the *Contractor Written Acknowledgement of Completion of Cybersecurity Training Program (PDF)* form, and return them to me **no later than, Thursday, April 30, 2020** for upload into the SCOR.
