



**INTERAGENCY COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT**

This agreement is made and entered into by the Community Council of the Rio Grande Valley and Hidalgo County Judge's Office/Office of Emergency Management. The purpose of this agreement is to establish a working and cooperative relationship between the parties in order to plan services appropriate for each agency's clients.

**2-1-1 Texas, a program of the Council**, offers a centralized comprehensive, cross-category set of resources to individuals, families, groups and service organizations in Starr, Hidalgo, Cameron and Willacy counties.

The Non-Financial agreement becomes effective immediately and will remain in effect until terminated by either party. **2-1-1 Texas program** agrees to be the first point of contact for callers seeking resources before, during and after a disaster or event, coordinated by the Hidalgo County Judge's Office/Office of Emergency Management through preparation, planning, mitigation and response.

This is an agreement of mutual support and collaboration with the common goal of coordinating information and referral services for mutual current and potential clients.

The cooperation of our agencies and our staff is very important in our efforts to promote the self-sufficiency of low-income families in our community. Together, we can make a difference in the lives of the families we serve.
