Ms. Reyes,

I have attached the Multiple Use Agreement(MUA) form that will need to be filled out and submitted to us for review and approval. The exceptions to number 24 are:

**Exhibit B – Metes and Bounds can be satisfied by the section and control numbers(I can provide this information to you, I would just need to know the exact location), a map showing the location, and an adequate description of the area**

**Exhibit D – Certificate of Insurance can be fulfilled if the second party is self-insured. If the local entity will have an outside contractor do work for them, then the city or county must have a Form 1560 filled out and presented to the district.**

We must have a copy of the local entity's resolution/ordinance that shows that the governing body has the authority to enter into an agreement with TxDOT.

All blanks and lines need to be filled in. This includes the date when the second party signs the agreement, the signature block and the District Engineers approval.

We cannot alter the wording of the MUA.

The MUA will need to be reviewed by our Maintenance Division in Austin. Depending on the roadway we may also need approval from the FHWA.

Work will not be permitted until the agreement is fully executed.

We would need at least two original agreements signed.
