BACKGROUND

On March 17, 2020, pursuant to the authority under Texas Government Code Section 418.108, Hidalgo County Judge Richard Cortez issued a Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency due to the imminent threat arising from the Coronavirus (COVID-19). On March 22, 2020, in accordance with Texas Government Code Section 418.108(b), the Commissioners Court of Hidalgo County issued an Order of Continuance of Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency that affirmed the activation of the Hidalgo County Emergency Management Plan and extends the Declaration of Local Disaster.

Hidalgo County Precinct 4 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic public health emergency has identified a need for a comprehensive and aggressive communication strategy and campaign to disseminate County information on the efforts to mitigate the spread of the virus, programs and Assistance County offers to the public as part of the response to COVID-19.

The 2010 Census has indicated that Hidalgo County has a low to moderate income level of 54.75% and the Texas Department of State Health Services estimated Hidalgo County’s population to be 1,005,539. With this large impoverished population, but limited lab testing capacity, the detection, mitigation and response to COVID-19 has been largely impacted. Current public health directive emphasizing the importance of preventing and mitigating the spread of COVID-19. However, given our current trend, we are projected to have a large segment of the population severely impacted by the pandemic.

COMPLIANCE

In compliance with the national preparedness goal under the Presidential Policy Directive (PPD-8), the Homeland Security Presidential Directives 5 (HSPD-5) and the Centers for Disease Control and

Prevention, Public Health Emergency Preparedness and Response Capability 12 and pursuant to the Order of Continuance of Declaration of Local Disaster for Public health Emergency that affirmed the activation of the Hidalgo County Emergency Management Plan and extends the Declaration of Local Disaster, request the Court's approval for the necessary Public Service Announcements (PSAs) to address the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic public health emergency.

ADMINISTRATION

Approval of the item is consistent with Hidalgo County's response to COVID-19 while continuing to provide necessary services to mitigate, control and manage the spread of the virus.

AGENDA ITEM CAPTION

- A. - C. Ratification of PO's 820126/Univision/\$2,940.00 and 820184/Entravision Radio/\$11,700.00 for urgent and necessary Public Service Announcements to disseminate COVID-information on public health and economic support initiatives and programs;
- D. Action to approve the budget for the Communication Strategy/Campaign at the amount of \$_____ per _____ to end on _____.

RECOMMENDATION

Approval of the items will allow Hidalgo County to continue to respond to the current public health emergency of COVID-19. As previously stated, with these large impoverished population and continued incurred case search; therefore, this is deemed a reasonable and necessary expenditure related to the County's COVID-19 Public Health Response. Expenditures will be charged to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act and/or other assistance available to address the COVID-19 public health emergency.
