Finding of No Significant Impact for a NEPA Assigned Federal Aid Project

Proposed Action:	Liberty Boulevard		
Project Limits:	From U.S. Highway 83 to FM 2221

In accordance with 23 CFR Section 771.119 and Section 771.121, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has determined that the Liberty Boulevard project will not have a significant impact on the human or natural environment.

This Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the Preferred Alternative is based on the final Environmental Assessment dated May 2015 and the entire project record. This decision documents the selection of Alternative E presented in the final EA as the Preferred Alternative, which is described as:

The proposed Phase I improvements (CSJ: 0921-02-194), from U.S. 83 to Mile 3 Road, would construct a 69 foot wide five lane urban roadway consisting of a 14 foot wide continuous center turning lane, two 12 foot wide inside travel lanes, two 14 foot wide outside shared use lanes and a five foot wide sidewalk on the west side of the roadway within a 120 foot wide ROW.

The proposed Phase II improvements (CSJ: 0921-02-322), from Mile 3 Road to FM 2221, would construct a 44 foot wide rural roadway consisting of two 12 foot wide travel lanes and two 10 foot wide shoulders within a proposed 120 foot wide ROW.

A Notice of Availability of the draft EA was issued on February 28, 2015.

A Notice Affording Opportunity for a Public Hearing was published on February 28, March 16, and March 25, 2015.

No changes to the draft EA were made as a result of comments received on the draft EA during the posted comment period.

A Notice Affording Opportunity for a Public Hearing packet and certification that the required hearing opportunity was offered has been prepared and is available for review on request.

The final EA, the Opportunity for Public Hearing packet, Public Meeting Summary and Analysis, Biological Technical Report, and reports contained in the file of record have been independently evaluated by TxDOT and determined to adequately and accurately discuss the need, purpose, alternatives, environmental issues, impacts of the proposed project, and appropriate mitigation measures. These documents provide sufficient evidence and analysis for determining that preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement is not required. These documents are incorporated by reference into this decisional document.

Based upon TxDOT's review and consideration of the analysis and evaluation contained in the EA for this project, and after careful consideration of all social, economic, and environmental factors, including input from the public involvement process, TxDOT hereby issues this Finding of No Significant Impact for the Liberty Boulevard project from U.S. Highway 83 to FM 2221.

TxDOT will ensure adherence and completion of all project commitments described in the final EA May 2015, Section V. TxDOT will ensure that any and all local, state, or federal permit requirements and



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conditions are met and otherwise complied with.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and the Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
