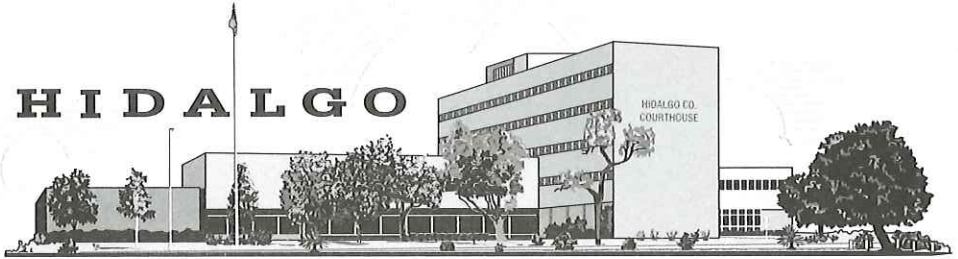

Pursuant to Local Government Code § 111. 0707 SPECIAL BUDGET FOR REVENUE FROM INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACTS:

The county auditor shall certify to the commissioner's court the receipt of all public or private grant or aid money that is available for disbursement in a fiscal year but not included in the budget for that fiscal year. On certification, the court shall adopt a special budget for the limited purpose of spending the grant or aid money for its intended purpose.

**AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
TROPICAL TEXAS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
AND
THE COUNTY OF HIDALGO, BY AND THROUGH THE HIDALGO
COUNTY CRIMINAL DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE**

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2019, Tropical Texas Behavioral Health (hereinafter referred to as 'TTBH') and County of Hidalgo, by and through the Hidalgo County Criminal District Attorney's Office (hereinafter referred to as the 'County') entered into a Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Assitive Outpatient treatment program (hereinafter referred to as 'AOT') will provide the counties served with a means of delivering medically prescribed mental health treatment to individuals living in a community under the terms of a local court order for such treatment; and

WHEREAS, TTBH was awarded a Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA) Grant (hereinafter referred to as the 'Grant') to fund this program, of which certain funds may be expended to support the AOT program; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Agreement was to engage in contractual arrangements carry out a portion of the programmatic effort, or for the acquisition of routine goods or services under the Grant, including consultation of professional advice and services, related to identifying individuals that may have mental illness and/or co-occurring substance abuse disorders that could be subject to criminal prosecution and in lieu of incarceration or further prosecution refer these individuals to community based behavioral health services; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Interlocal Agreement as hereinafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the terms and provisions of this Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement and for good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Tropical Texas Behavioral Health and the County of Hidalgo, by and through the Hidalgo County Criminal District Attorney's Office, effective as of the 1st day of October 2020, hereby agrees to the following amendment to the Agreement:

1. Section 2.2 Compensation. Is hereby replace and incorporated by reference as follows:
"Base Compensation shall be defined as compensation for services provided and applicable fringe benefits. The maximum entitlement for compensation for County District Attorney services to the AOT shall not exceed \$ 8,333.00 during the term of this amendment.
2. This Interlocal Agreement shall be extended to January 31, 2021.

3. Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions of the original Agreement remain in full effect.
