RE: “Sole Source Declaration” – Wireless CCTV

Hidalgo County Sheriff’s Office requires the purchase of cutting edge, state of the art software, equipment/accessories, and maintenance of such for the purpose of wireless surveillance capable of operating live feed and recorded video that can be accessed remotely from a control room, PC, laptop, iPad, PDA, iPhone or Android device.

Wireless CCTV, L.L.C. (WCCTV) is a market leading provider of rapidly deployable, portable CCTV and surveillance systems. The systems operate over wireless technologies including 4G, 3G and CDMA cell-phone technology as well as satellite, Wi-Fi and broadband networks. WCCTV is the only provider of a Verizon certified hybrid NVR/DVR solution with integrated one-box modem, DVR , telemetry and alarm functionality.

The 4G Nano is WCCTV’s smallest surveillance device to date. It is specifically designed for integrated surveillance requirements where the solution needs to be re-deployable, mobile, covert, or body-worn, and the user requires remote access to live or recorded video images without geographical restriction. The unit uses a Compact Flash card for digital evidential quality recording and can be monitored either live or recorded video or audio footage from any remote location via 3G HSUPA mobile phone connectivity. It is completely portable and easy to install. The same images and videos can be viewed by up to six (6) people from six (6) different locations at the same time. WCCTV systems are the only fully integrated DVR and embedded modem solution that has been certified as such along with full environmental certification for hot/cold weather operation. It is a one camera system that can be utilized with any industry standard fixed, PTZ, analogue or IP cameras. The WCCTV NANO allows the user to integrate other sensors such as GPS, audio, alarms and telemetry which can then be transmitted and recorded via wireless networks. Each image is date and time stamped and digitally watermarked so it can be used evidentially.

Therefore, Hidalgo County Sheriff’s Office requires the purchase of the Wireless CCTV 4G Nano, supporting equipment, connections and warranties to include if necessary; all other related Hidalgo County Law Enforcement Agencies (from all funding sources).

This Sole Source Declaration is to remain in effect unless otherwise revoked by Hidalgo County Commissioners Court.
