

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Hidalgo County, that the General Victim Assistance Grant Program be operated for the period of October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022.

WHEREAS, The County of Hidalgo Commissioners Court agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Texas Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division grant application; and

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Hidalgo County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court designates Hidalgo County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of Hidalgo County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court approves submission of the grant application for the General Victim Assistance Grant Program to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division (CJD).
