

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE 2021-2022 COLONIA FUNDS: CONSTRUCTION; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Hidalgo County desired to develop a viable urban community including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of Hidalgo County to apply for funding under the 2021-2022 Texas Community Development Block Grant Program - Colonia Funds: Construction with the Texas Department of Agriculture;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program Application for the Colonia Fund: Construction is hereby authorized to be filed out on behalf of Hidalgo County with the Texas Department of Agriculture.
2. That the County's application be placed in competition for funding under the 2021-2022 Colonia Fund: Construction.
3. That the application be up to \$1,000,000.00 of grant funds to provide lift station improvements.
4. That the Commissioners' Court directs and designates the County Judge as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the County's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program.
5. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition, and civil rights requirements.
