## Acknowledgment of Obligations for 2021 "Road to Recycling" Regional Tire Collection Project Saturday, May 8, 2021

Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council (LRGVDC) is pleased to announce the 2021 "Road to Recycling" Tire Collection Event. This project is funded through LRGVDC and TCEQ. All the counties and cities across the Valley were invited to participate. LRGVDC will be responsible for tire disposal fees only. LRGVDC will continue to develop long-term, sustainable best practices for our region.

If the County chooses to participate in this event this acknowledgment form must be signed acknowledging roles and responsibilities.

The County of \_\_\_\_\_, acknowledges that the LRGVDC will only pay for disposal fees for the tires collected on May 8, 2021, and any other fees or responsibilities will be the city/county obligation to pay, provide and/or transport. The Interlocal Agreement between LRGVDC and City of Edinburg requires that the participating County shall maintain in continuous force and effect throughout the term of this Agreement public liability and property damage insurance in the amount of \$500,000 (with a deductible there under of not more than \$250,000), covering the participating County's transportation of the Waste Material. If requested, the participating County shall furnish City of Edinburg (COE) with a certificate evidencing such insurance coverage. The participating County shall notify the COE of the cancellation of or any material change in insurance policy.
