**SECOND AMENDMENT TO MASTER AGREEMENT

This **AMENDMENT** to the Master Agreement **C-18-219-11-06** is made this ____ **day of July, 2021**, by and between the **County of Hidalgo, Texas** (hereinafter referred to as the “County”) and **Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP**.

WHEREAS, on or about November 6, 2018, Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP and the County of Hidalgo entered into a Master Agreement for tax collection services effective January 1, 2019;

WHEREAS, section 6.01 of the Master Agreement provides that the Agreement term shall be for a three (3) year term, with the County’s option to renew for an additional one (1) year term;

WHEREAS, section 6.01 of the Master Agreement, as amended, reflects an expiration date of December 31, 2021, which is three (3) years after the January 1, 2019, effective date;

WHEREAS, the County and Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP desire to amend the Master Agreement for tax collection services and provide the County with the option to renew for three (3) additional one (1) year terms;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the terms and provisions of this Amendment to the Master Agreement and for good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP and the County of Hidalgo, Texas hereby agree to the following amendment to the Master Agreement:

1. Section 6.01 of the Master Service Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

“The Agreement term shall be for a three (3) year term, with the County’s option to renew for an additional three (3) one (1) year terms for the same fees, rates, terms and conditions.”

2. Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions of Master Agreement, as amended, remain in full all other provisions in the original master agreement will remain in effect.
