

**NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC OF A MEETING OF THE  
COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS  
IN CONSIDERATION OF ACTION TO AMEND  
PROFESSIONAL LEGAL SERVICES**

**(Pursuant to Section 2254.1036 of the Texas Government Code and Tax Code Sections 6.30,  
33.07, 33.08, 33.11, and 33.48 for the collection of delinquent tax collections services)**

Notice is hereby given that the Commissioners Court of the County of Hidalgo, Texas (the County) will be conducting a meeting on Tuesday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. at the Hidalgo County Commissioners Courtroom located in the Hidalgo County Courthouse Annex III, 100 E. Cano, Edinburg, Texas. The purpose of the meeting is to consider and take action on all items on the posted agenda pursuant to Texas Government Code Chapter 551; this includes but is not limited to and amend the current professional legal services contract to perform all legal services necessary to collect delinquent taxes and penalties pursuant to Sections 6.30, 33.07, 33.08, 33.11, and 33.48 of the Texas Code.

The County requires that delinquent taxes and penalties be collected as provided by law. The specialized legal services required cannot be performed by the attorneys and supporting personnel of the County due to the respective cost, infrastructure and technology needed to perform these services. The engagement of an attorney/law firm in a professional services contract, and amendment, for the collection of said fines, fees and court costs owed to the County is necessary to assist in obtaining the maximum amount of outstanding delinquent taxes and penalties owed and in the most cost effective manner.

The selected attorney/law firm is well qualified and was chosen on the basis of demonstrated competence, qualifications and experience in the requested specialized legal services. The Commissioners Court desires to amend the agreement for services that the Firm will perform for all legal services necessary to collect delinquent taxes and penalties provided by Sections 6.30, 33.07, 33.08, 33.11, and 33.48 as authorized by the Texas Tax Code with no change to the current fees, rates, terms and conditions. Notice regarding any future Commissioners Court action related to the final engagement of an attorney/law firm for these specialized legal services will be provided.
