RATIONALE/NEED: The purpose of the Inter Local Agreement is to assist the La Joya ISD personnel with enforcing the Compulsory School Attendance Law and truancy statutes in order to maximize student attendance. The County is responsible for a local match of \$36,491.49 and the district provides \$36,491.49(50%) to continue implementation of the project for the 2020-2021 school year.
