

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE
COUNTY OF HIDALGO, TEXAS AND
LOWER RIO GRANDE VALLEY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM AGREEMENT (“Agreement”) is made and entered on this 19th day of October 2021, by and between **THE COUNTY OF HIDALGO, TEXAS**, (“County”) and the **Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council** (“LRGVDC”), by and through Valley Metro.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on _____, County and LRGVDC, a voluntary association of local governments awarded a Federal Transit Administration Grant, entered into a memorandum Agreement to further facilitate the funding of a public bus transportation route in the Downtown Edinburg Square Courthouse area.

WHEREAS, County is a unit of local government of the State of Texas, charged with providing public services to improve the health, safety, accessibility, mobility, use of county services, and quality of life for the residents of the County of Hidalgo;

WHEREAS, Paragraph 4.02 of the Agreement provides for a Term commencing on September 22, 2020 and continuing through August 30, 2021, and further provides that “[t]he parties may agree in writing to extend the Agreement beyond the term period identified in this paragraph.”;

WHEREAS, County and LRGVDC now desire to amend the Agreement and exercise their right to extend the Agreement beyond the term period;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the terms and provisions set forth herein, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, County and LRGVDC hereby agree to the following amendment to the Agreement.

1. Paragraph “4.02” of the Agreement is hereby modified and replaced as follows:
“4.02 **Term.** LRGVDC agrees to perform services outlined above and continue such services commencing on August 31, 2021 and continuing such services through October 31, 2022. The parties may agree in writing to extend the Agreement beyond the term period identified in this paragraph.”
2. Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement, remain in full force and effect. County and LRGVDC ratify and confirm the terms and provisions of the Agreement as amended herein.
