**WHEREAS**, The Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Hidalgo County, that the Body-Worn Camera FY2022 be operated for the period of March 1, 2022 to February 28, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, The County of Hidalgo Commissioners Court agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Texas Office of the Governor Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division. grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Hidalgo County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

**WHEREAS**, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court designates the Hidalgo County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court approves submission of the grant application for the Body-Worn Camera FY2022 to the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division.
